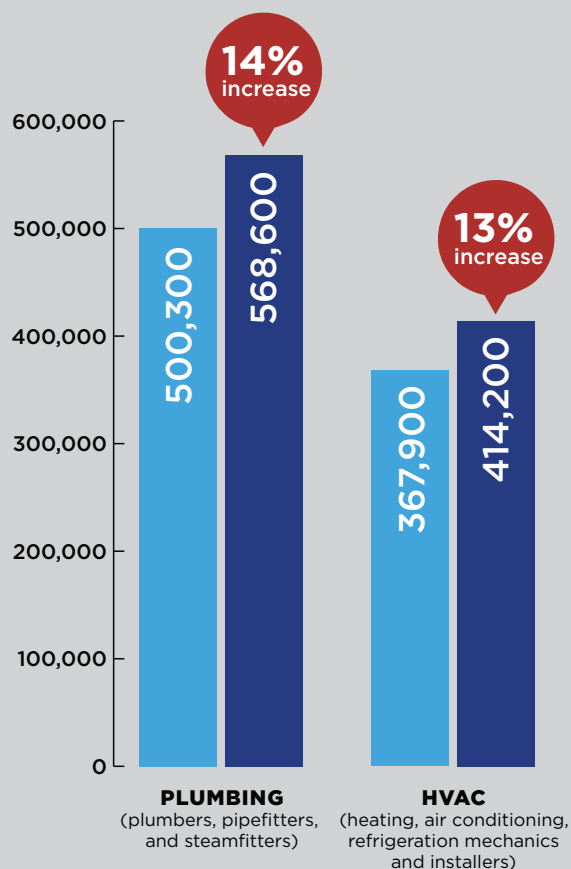


Plumbing and HVAC Careers are IN DEMAND

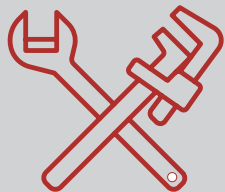
