Plumbing Contestants

- Install a basic three-piece bathroom—toilet, sink, and shower
- Install water and drain, waste and vent lines
- Determine rough-in locations
- Establish grade lines for installing plumbing
- Install vents and cleanouts
- Rough-in waste and vent lines
- Rough-in water supply lines
- Secure horizontal and vertical lines of pipe to wood and metal surfaces

HVAC Contestants

- Demonstrate proper oxyacetylene brazing techniques
- Perform a pressure test and leak test, and pull a vacuum on a system
- Demonstrate proper recovery procedures
- Take a full set of readings on a functioning package unit and measure airflow, static pressure, and capacity from the package unit
- Perform a hands-on diagnostic and repair on a package unit
- Take a written test evaluating HVAC knowledge
